Homer-Center Park and Recreation is committed to providing safe aquatic facilities and programs and strives to reduce risks by insisting all participants follow safety rules and instructions that are designed to protect the participants' safety. You are solely responsible for determining if you or your child/ward are physically fit and/or adequately skilled for the activities associated with this pool pass. It is always advisable, especially if the participant is pregnant, disabled in any way, or recently suffered an illness, injury, or impairment, to consult a physician before undertaking any physical/aquatic activity.

Swimming and other aquatic activities challenge and engage the physical, mental, and emotional resources of each participant. However, despite careful and proper preparation, instruction, medical advice, conditioning, and equipment, there is still a risk of serious injury, including but not limited to drowning, head/brain injury, and cervical/spine injury.

Understandably, not all hazards and dangers can be foreseen. The very nature of swimming and aquatic activities are hazardous and risky, including but no limited to fatigue and overexertion, poor swimming skills, failing to avoid dangerous areas, delay in emergency response time, horseplay, diving or cannon-balling into shallow water and striking the bottom, lack of conditioning, becoming disoriented, striking other swimmers, slipping or falling on the deck or within the locker facility, and all other circumstances inherent to aquatic activities and aquatic facilities. In this regard, it must be recognized that it is impossible for The Homer-Center Recreation and Parks Board to guarantee absolute safety.

I further agree to waive and relinquish all claims I or my minor child/ward may have as a result of participating in these programs/activities against the Homer-Center Recreation and Parks Board, Homer-Center School District, Center Township, and Homer City Borough or any other associated entity, including its officials, agents, volunteers, and employees.

I do hereby fully release and forever discharge the Homer-Center Recreation and Parks Board, Homer Center School District, Center Township, and Homer City Borough from any and all claims for injuries, damages, or loss that my minor child/ward or I may have or which may accrue to me or my minor child/ward and arising out of, connected with, or in any way associated with the programs/activities.

The COVID-19 pandemic presents various challenges concerning this contagious illness. Some severe outcomes have been reported in children, and children with mild or even asymptomatic cases of COVID-19 can spread the infection to others who may be far more vulnerable. Certain vulnerable individuals may have greater health risks associated with exposure to COVID-19, including individuals with serious underlying health conditions such as, but not limited to: high blood pressure, chronic lung disease, diabetes, asthma, and those whose immune systems that are compromised by chemotherapy for cancer, and other conditions requiring such therapy. While it is not possible to eliminate all risk of being infected with or furthering the spread of COVID-19, the risk can be reduced. The Homer-Center Parks and Recreation Board has taken necessary precautions and comply with guidelines from the federal, state, and local governments, the CDC and the PA Departments of Health and Education to reduce the risks to children and their families. As knowledge regarding COVID-19 is constantly changing, these guidelines may be modified to further implement steps needed to decrease the risk of exposure. Additionally, the Homer-Center Recreation and Parks Board has adopted internal protocols to reduce the risk of transmission.

By signing this form, the undersigned acknowledge, after having undertaken to review and understand both the symptoms and possible consequences of infection, that (1) we are aware of the contagious nature of COVID-19 and the risks that we may be exposed to or contract COVID-19 or other communicable diseases by at the pool; (2) such exposure or infection may result in serious illness, personal injury, permanent disability and/or death; (3) this risk may result from or be compounded by the actions, omissions, or negligence of others; (4) participants will, in the course of using the pool, interact with and likely have physical contact with people from their own family, as well as other families, including families from other areas of the Commonwealth; (5) while risks can be managed in part, the Homer-Center Recreation and Parks Board cannot eliminate such risks nor guarantee that transmission will not occur for those using the pool; and (6) using the pool at any time, and especially during the COVID-19 pandemic, is strictly voluntary. Notwithstanding the risks associated with COVID-19, we agree that we are voluntarily allowing the individuals named in this application to use the pool. We willingly agree to comply with the stated guidelines from the federal, state, and local governments, the CDC and the PA Departments of Health and Education and the directions of the Homer-Center Recreation and Parks staff to reduce the risks to children and their families and to limit the exposure and spread of COVID-19 and other communicable diseases.

I have read and fully understand the above important information. Warning of risk, assumption of risk, and waiver and release of all claims. I further understand and agree that violating any of the rules, regulations, and/or directives of the Homer-Center Recreation and Parks Board, or its staff, (including COVID-19 policies) is cause for removal from the pool without refund.
